Top prize in the stableford competition went to Megan Edwards from Hill Barn Golf Club with 43 points, with Zhane Mayo, from Beauport Park, near Hastings, second on 41 points and Worthing's Anya Olsen third with 40 points.

The Di Langridge Trophy for best scratch score was won by Jelina Fernando from Mid Sussex Golf Club.

Top prize for the eight hole stableford for less experienced players was won by Anna Montojo from Windlesham School with 36 points and Worthing's Emily Coles came second with 24 points. A 9 hole putting competition was won by Ayesha Gyening, who plays at Rustington.

Organiser Sarah Cooper-Olsen said: "The girls faced some very tough conditions, with strong winds but showed great enthusiasm.
