Sussex Order of Merit 2018/2019 Information for Players

The objectives of the Sussex Ladies Order of Merit (OOM) are to provide a measure of the most successful and committed golfers in Sussex as well as to provide a clear and transparent process for county first team selection.

Any player of 3 handicap or lower will be eligible to participate in the Sussex Ladies OOM. Players will be awarded points accordingly. The top four players will be invited to represent the county in County Match Week. The remaining places on the county team will be selected by the County Captain, Vice or Past Captain, Team Representative, County Champion and by invitation, the County Junior Organiser and the County Training Officer/Team Manager. The County Captain and/or her selection committee may invite ladies/girls to attend training sessions for the First team even though they do not quite meet the handicap limit stipulated.

Eligible players interested in selection for the County First Team must register for the OOM at sclgaoom@gmail.com It is the players' responsibility to report their scores to the OOM registrar on sclgaoom@gmail.com

Those players who reduce their handicap to 3 or lower during the season should inform the county to ensure their inclusion in the OOM.

A trophy will be awarded to the winner of the OOM each year.

The OOM will commence immediately after the conclusion of the County Championship to the completion of the County Championship in the following year. The committee reserve the right to make annual revisions to the OOM process.

Players will be awarded the highest points in each category except Q1 – Q6 and M1-M3 where players may return their best six scores.

Those players studying overseas and playing golf for their university will not be expected to participate in OOM events. These players may be chosen to play for the First team as a selection committee pick. Juniors will not be expected to enter the OOM and may be selected to play by the selection committee. There will be a 30% reduction of points awarded for competitions restricted by age (Seniors/Juniors) Events with small entries (24 or less) will only receive 50% of the points.

Order of Merit results will be updated and posted on the website.

Players who do not meet the criteria may jeopardise their place in the team.
