Inter Club Championship - Divisions 1 (handicap & scratch), 2, 3 and 4. See the Inter Club Championship Rules 2020
All matches to be played by Tuesday 30 June 2020.

Quarter-finals Division 2: 15 July 2020, Division 3: 20 July 2020 and Division 4: 30 July 2020

Semi-finals Divisions 1: 6 July 2020, Divisions 2, 3 and 4: – 6 August 2020 Finals All Divisions – 28 August 2020

Sussex Scratch Inter-Club Knock-out Foursomes

Morrice Inter-Club Knock-out Foursomes

Three pairs from each club - played off handicap. Maximum combined handicap allowance for each pair is 50. Any pair exceeding 50 is not eligible to play in this competition. Format: ½ difference of combined handicaps. First round to be played on the first drawn course, thereafter there will be a re-draw in each section for Home and Away, details of which will be posted on the website. At least three alternative dates, including at least one weekend or one weekday date if requested, must be offered by the home side when arranging matches. On the day of the match, ½ hour prior to first tee time, captains shall simultaneously exchange match sheets stating nominated pairs in order of play including individual handicaps. Failure to comply with this will result in disqualification. All matches **MUST** be 18 holes and played to a result, no halving, until a team is two matches up, unless the Captain wishes to concede a walkover. Captains should try to re-fix date if temporary greens, or composite holes in operation. If unable to do so, agree to play the course of the day. No bucket holes are allowed. No green fee chargeable. First round to be played by 12 April 2020, second round by 17 May 2020 and third round by 21 June 2020. Quarter-finals to be played during July/August. Semi-finals and finals during August/September. The Team Captain must provide proof of current CONGU competition handicap for players in their team for quarter-finals, semi-finals and final. Players with individual handicaps higher than 28 or pairs with joint handicaps higher than 50 **will not be accepted for this competition**. 18 hole stableford competition off ½ of combined handicap. Notes

1. Buggies may be used by those players who can provide a valid current medical certificate of disability (including temporary disability). The policy on buggy use is in line with the England Golf "Policy on Use of Golf Buggies". A Club may decide that on the match day buggies may not be used due to Health and Safety considerations. The use of buggies is subject to availability.
2. The Committee reserves the right to alter the playing conditions of any competition.
3. Mobile phones may be used on the course as Distance Measuring Devices and for accessing the R&A Rules app. Phones should be set on "silent" and may not be used to send text messages or to make phone calls except in an emergency. Infringement will be loss of hole in match play or two stroke penalty in stroke play competitions.
4. Distance Measuring Devices may be used which comply with the Rules of Golf. The penalty for improper use: in match play is loss of hole and in stroke play a 2 shot penalty. Any further breaches will result in disqualification.
5. Proof of current CONGU competition handicap must be produced if requested
6. Photographs of the winning teams will be published on the website. Any player who does not wish her picture to be on the website should opt out of the photo.
7. **Caddies will not be allowed for any competitions**
